RESOLUTION 2016-15 Adopted August 2, 2016

A RESOLUTION TO REJECT ALL BIDS FOR THE 2016 SIDEWALK PROGRAM AND TO REBID THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell desires to enter into a contract for the repair and/or replacement of sidewalks, integral approaches/aprons and related areas pursuant to the 2016 Sidewalk Program; and

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the contracting procedure to be followed for the project in Resolution 2016-13 adopted June 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City opened and publicly read bids for this project on July 19, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted were unacceptable to the City of Powell, insofar as they significantly exceeded the engineer's estimate, and Powell desires to reject all bids and rebid the project under the process set forth in Resolution 2016-13.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That all of the bids for the furnishing of labor and material for the 2016 Sidewalk Program are hereby rejected, and the City Manager is hereby directed to re-advertise for new bids, using the process set forth in Resolution 2016-13, and to return to the respective bidders their bid bonds.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2016-15 was adopted.
