

City of Powell, Ohio ORDINANCE 2016-65

Adopted December 6, 2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A BID TO MILLER CABLE COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$212,632.50 FOR THE GRACE DRIVE/EAST OLENTANGY STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has received bids from contractors to complete the Grace Drive/East Olentangy Street Traffic Signal Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, Council and Staff recommend Miller Cable Company as the lowest and best bidder for the above-mentioned project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby awards the bid for the Grace Drive/East Olentangy Street Traffic Signal Improvements Project to Miller Cable Company and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for the purpose of completing the abovementioned project pursuant to the contract documents.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to begin this project; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
