

City of Powell, Ohio RESOLUTION 2017-09

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NECESSITY TO REPAIR OR REPLACE SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF POWELL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Powell, the City Engineer has conducted a survey of sidewalks, integral approaches/aprons and related areas which are in need of repair or replacement in the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such survey, the City Engineer has developed a list of properties requiring repair and/or replacement of such areas; and

WHEREAS, notice has been provided to the owners of such properties pursuant to Section 905.05(d) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council therefore has determined that repair and/or replacement of the sidewalks, integral approaches/aprons and related areas on these properties is now necessary;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare a solicitation for bids including all costs and administrative costs associated with completing the public improvements and/or repairs as reflected on the list attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-09 was adopted.
