

City of Powell, Ohio ORDINANCE 2018-21 Adopted May 15, 2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH EMH&T FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE RESURFACING AND RELATED APPURTENANCES OF SAWMILL PARKWAY, BETWEEN SELDOM SEEN AND HOME ROADS (DEL-CR609-2.24, PID 105806), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to engineer the improvements for Sawmill Parkway; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement with EMH&T.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with EMH&T, in a form acceptable to the Director of Law and in a contract amount of approximately \$85,405.00 for professional engineering services related to the resurfacing and related appurtenances on Sawmill Parkway between Seldom Seen and Home Roads (DEL-CR609-2.24, PID 105806).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from EMH&T's necessity to commence engineering services as soon as possible; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
