ORDINANCE 2017-29

Adopted June 20, 2017

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LEFT TURNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF OLENTANGY STREET (STATE ROUTE 750) AND LIBERTY STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS. Council has determined that it is necessary to prohibit left turns at the intersection of Olentanay Street (State Route 750) and Liberty Street during specific hours; and

WHEREAS. Council has the authority to direct placement and maintenance of local traffic devices; and

WHEREAS. Council has determined that specified turn restrictions are an emergency necessary to maintain the safety on roadways with the City of Powell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That left turns shall be temporarily prohibited from Liberty Street to Olentanay Street (State Route 750) between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for a period of time until two weeks after the completion of the 315 improvements, as determined by the City Manager.

Section 2: That the traffic signage be installed pursuant to the recommendations of the City Engineer.

That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council Section 3: concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure Section 4: necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
