

## ORDINANCE 2019-34 Adopted August 6, 2019

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RALPH ANDERSEN & ASSOCIATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EXECUTIVE SEARCH SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF POWELL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to engage Ralph Andersen & Associates to provide executive search services for the City of Powell; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement, which includes developing a position profile, personnel outreach, marketing strategy, and screening process.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Ralph Andersen & Associates, in a form acceptable to the Director of Law, in a contract amount of \$29,750 for executive search services.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the City's desire to commence these services expeditiously and without interruption to City services; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
