



**RESOLUTION 2020-14**  
Adopted July 7, 2020

**A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT FUNDS DISTRIBUTED UNDER THE COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND TO THE CITY OF POWELL SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY ONLY FOR COSTS PERMITTED UNDER THE FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT AND ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS AS IS NECESSARY PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL 481 BEFORE RECEIVING SAID FUNDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, ("CARES Act") was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act in House Bill 481 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

**WHEREAS**, H.B. 481, requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the Act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801, and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Powell is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, Powell City Council believes that accepting such funds pursuant to the required conditions is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Powell.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The City affirms that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in the City's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to take all necessary action to:


- (1) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the City's local coronavirus relief fund to the County Treasurer;
- (2) On or before December 28, 2020, pay the balance of any money in the City's local coronavirus relief fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and
- (3) Provide any information related to any payments received under the process established by the General Assembly to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date permitted by law.
