

ORDINANCE 2020-15

Adopted September 1, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL FUEL SHARING AGREEMENT WITH LIBERTY TOWNS. IP FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHARING EXPENSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell ("City") and Liberty Township ("Township") desire to find ways to minimize expenses within their municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to enter into an agreement with the Township for the purpose of sharing the expenses relating to fueling vehicles used by their respective municipalities, and hereby determines that an Intergovernmental Fuel Sharing Agreement is in the best interest of the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to an enter into an Intergovernmental Fuel Sharing Agreement with Liberty Township in a form substantially similar to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware Township, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to begin this project; **WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
