AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GRANICUS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING LIVESTREAMING AND ELECTRONIC AGENDA/PACKET MANAGEMENT FOR THE CITY OF POWELL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to begin live streaming its public meetings and providing electronic agenda/packet capabilities in a continuing effort to provide transparency to the public, while allowing the City to provide services in the most cost-effective manner; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement with Granicus;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Granicus, in a form substantially similar to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council Section 2: concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary Section 3: for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants in order to seek reimbursement for relief under the CARES Act before the submission deadline expires.
