



ORDINANCE 2020-29
Adopted November 4, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION, REVISING ORDINANCE 2020-14, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2020-14 authorized the City administration to request a share of grant funds from the CARES Act to assist the City in offsetting costs incurred to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus and Ordinance 2020-14 authorized the creation of the local Coronavirus Relief Fund and supplemental appropriation; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly account for the City's allocation of these grant dollars, which equal \$805,295.94, governmental entities in the State of Ohio that receive CARES Act funding are required to account for these monies through the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That there is hereby appropriated as a revised Special Fund, the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF)(Fund 260) - \$805,295.94.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary to provide for the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the City in an effort to account for CARES Act grant funding and as such will be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

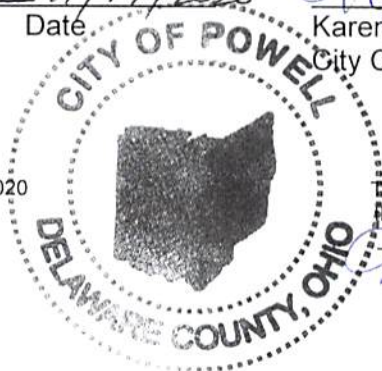


