

ORDINANCE 2020-36

Adopted January 5, 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT GROUP FOR ANNUAL STREET RATINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City rates its streets on a biennial basis; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to contract with Pavement Management Group to perform street rating services for the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Pavement Management Group, in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the biennial rating of City streets.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to begin this project; **WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
