



ORDINANCE 2021-03
Adopted February 16, 2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FRAZIERHEIBY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING COMMUNICATION AND EDUCATION SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF POWELL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to utilize the services of a communication agency to assist it in providing information regarding the issue to be placed on the spring 2021 ballot to allow residents to gain information and ask questions in an effort to provide the best quality and desired services to City residents; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement with Frazierheiby;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Frazierheiby, in a form substantially similar to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

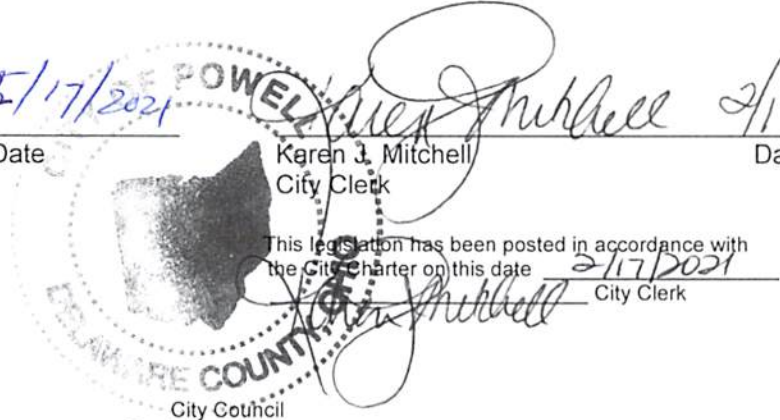
