



ORDINANCE 2021-34

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2021-31 AND THE APPROPRIATION THEREIN AND MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2021;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2021 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

Un-Appropriation:

Appropriation:

Seldom Seen TIF Public Improvements Fund

Seldom Seen TIF Debt Service Fund

General Fund
100-930-59530-02 \$ 582,933.54

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, in that it is in the best interest of the City of Powell to timely meet its obligations in the TIF Agreement. This ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.

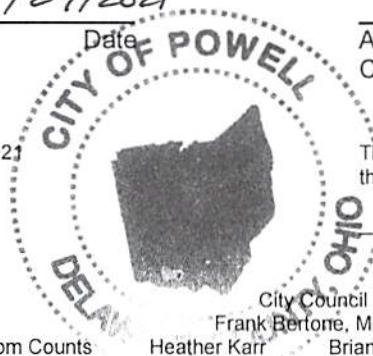
