

## ORDINANCE 2021-34 December 7, 2021

## AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2021-31 AND THE APPROPRIATION THEREIN AND MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2021;

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2021 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:
