

ORDINANCE 2022-37

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2022;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2022 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby makes the following adjustments:

Un-Appropriation

General Fund, Finance, Personnel	\$30,000
General Fund, Public Service, Personnel	\$12,521
Appropriations:	
General Fund, Public Information, Personnel	\$2,521
General Fund, Finance, Operating	\$40,000
Capital Projects Fund, Capital	\$44,900

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, in that it is in the best interest of the City of Powell to timely meet its obligations. This ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
