A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF POWELL AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, City Council appointed a Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee for the purpose of updating the City Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning and Steering Committee, which included members of the Planning and Zoning Commission, has prepared and updated the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Powell;

WHEREAS, after conducting two public hearings, and provided by the powers granted them pursuant to Section 11.01 of the City Charter and Chapter 713 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Planning and Zoning Commission has adopted the Comprehensive Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission submits such approved Comprehensive Plan to the City Council for its review and consideration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby confirms the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Powell by the Planning and Zoning Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.
