RESOLUTION 2015-14

Adopted November 4, 2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DELAWARE, OHIO CITY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, State of Ohio law authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powell currently uses the service of the Delaware City Prosecutor's office to prosecute all cases coming before the Delaware Municipal Court arising out of alleged violations of the Codified Ordinances of Powell; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is beneficial for the City of Powell to enter into an agreement with the Delaware, Ohio City Prosecutor's Office so that they may continue to provide that service.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Powell hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Delaware, Ohio City Prosecutor's Office in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2015-14 was adopted.
