A RESOLUTION STATING POWELL CITY COUNCIL'S INTENTION TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF LIBERTY ROAD AND SELDOM SEEN ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and the Delaware County Engineer have determined that improvements to the intersection of Liberty Road and Seldom Seen Road are necessary for the safety, convenience and welfare of the traveling public, and;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") allocates funds for transportation improvements as a part of the Highway Improvement Program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That improvements to the intersection of Liberty Road and Seldom Seen Road are hereby declared necessary for the safety, convenience and welfare of the public.

Section 2: That, upon receipt of a funding commitment by ODOT through the Highway Safety Improvement Program, the City shall undertake the Improvement, subject to approval of a cooperation agreement with Delaware County, and will provide any necessary funding for portions of the Improvement attributable to the City.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to file any necessary applications for the Improvements and to cooperate with any necessary agencies to develop the Improvements.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.
