

City of Powell, Ohio **RESOLUTION 2016-21**

Adopted November 15, 2016

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AND SUPPORT THE STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN (SWMP) FOR THE CITY OF POWELL, OHIO AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CERTIFY THE SWMP.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio has been designated an NPDES Phase II community by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency within its Phase II Final Rule published in the Federal Register on December 8, 1999 (64 FR 68722) and;

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio is required to submit to the State of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency the revised SWMP in meeting the requirements under the "Authorization For Small Municipal Storm Sewer Systems to Discharge Storm Water Under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System" - Permit Number OHQ000003, no later than December 2, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Powell recognizes that all Notices of Intent, Storm Water Management Plans, reports, certifications or information submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency must be signed by either a principal executive officer or ranking elected official; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio desires to comply with the NPDES Phase II storm water regulations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City of Powell hereby adopts and supports the revised Storm Water Management Plan, attached as Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference, which plan is designed to provide a means by which the City of Powell will meet the requirements of Permit Number OHQ000003.

Section 2: The City of Powell authorizes the City Manager to serve as the principal executive officer for the storm water management utility for the purposes of fulfilling the signatory requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's NPDES Phase II storm water program.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2016-21 was adopted.
