RESOLUTION 2017-01

Adopted February 7, 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH DELAWARE COUNTY FOR RESURFACING (MICRO SURFACING) OF SAWMILL PARKWAY.

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Engineer and the City Engineer have determined that resurfacing (micro surfacing) of Sawmill Parkway from the Franklin County line north to Seldom Seen Road is necessary for the safety, convenience and welfare of the traveling public, and;

WHEREAS, Delaware County is requesting that the City of Powell contribute approximately \$149,233.48 as the City's prorata share based on the amount of work performed in each jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That resurfacing (micro surfacing) of Sawmill Parkway from the Franklin County line north to Seldom Seen Road is hereby declared necessary for the safety, convenience and welfare of the public.

Section 2: That the City commits to provide funding in the approximate amount of \$149,233.48 toward said resurfacing (micro surfacing) of Sawmill Parkway within thirty days of receipt of an invoice for such contribution, subject to appropriation of necessary funds.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to cooperate with any necessary agencies and enter into a Cooperation Agreement with Delaware County in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and restated herein by reference.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-01 was adopted.
