RESOLUTION 2017-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE UNITED WAY OF DELAWARE COUNTY FOR THE INSTALLATION, PROMOTION AND MAINTENANCE OF BORN LEARNING TRAILS.

WHEREAS, the United Way of Delaware County and the City of Powell wish to enter into a partnership for the installation, promotion and maintenance of Born Learning Trails to build resiliency in our children by encouraging long-term social and emotion development skills and increase opportunities for families to interact together, and;

WHEREAS, the United Way of Delaware County is requesting that the City of Powell provide paved spaces to accommodate ten individual stations no more than three yards in length; assist in the promotion of the trail and ribbon cutting ceremony; and assist in providing a trail maintenance schedule for all park repairs, excluding paint and signage.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City commits to working with the United Way of Delaware County for the installation, promotion and maintenance of Born Learning Trails to build resiliency in our children by encouraging long-term social and emotion development skills and increase opportunities for families to interact together

- **Section 2:** That the City commits to provide paved spaces to accommodate ten individual stations no more than three yards in length; assist in the promotion of the trail and ribbon cutting ceremony; and assist in providing a trail maintenance schedule for all park repairs, excluding paint and signage.
- **Section 3:** That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the United Way of Delaware County in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and restated herein by reference.
- **Section 4:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.
