RESOLUTION 2017-17 Adopted July 18, 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENTS ACHIEVED IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC. AND THE CITY OF POWELL, OHIO, FOR THE SERGEANTS' UNIT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO FINALIZE THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS NEGOTIATED BETWEEN THE PARTIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio and Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. engaged in negotiations for a renewed contract and achieved a tentative agreement regarding full contract settlement for the Sergeants' Unit for the periods July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 and January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, tentative agreements were achieved by the parties and are being presented to the Council of the City of Powell, Ohio, for approval consistent with Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That City Council hereby approves and authorizes the tentative agreements reached by the parties in collective bargaining between the City of Powell and Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. for the bargaining unit consisting of Sergeants.

Section 2: That the City Manager shall be authorized to take any and all necessary steps and appropriate actions to finalize the collective bargaining agreements consistent with the terms of the negotiated tentative agreements.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-17 was adopted.
