## **RESOLUTION 2017-31** Adopted December 19, 2017

A RESOLUTION TO CONDITIONALLY ACCEPT AND BEGIN THE REQUIRED MINIMUM TWO-YEAR MAINTENANCE PERIOD FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WITH REGARD TO THE VERONA SUBDIVISION. PHASE 1, AS THE SAME IS DELINEATED UPON THE PLATS THEREOF RECORDED IN O.R. 1394, PAGE 2202, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO RECORDS.

the public improvements of the Verona Subdivision, Phase 1, are WHEREAS, completed to the extent that it does not appear to present undue health, safety, and welfare hazards to the citizens.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

That, pursuant to Section 1115.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Section 1: Powell, the public improvements of the Verona Subdivision, Phase 1, as the same is delineated upon the plats of Verona, Phase 1 of record in O.R. 1394, Page 2202, at the Delaware County, Ohio Recorder, are conditionally accepted by the City of Powell.

That this acceptance shall be conditioned upon: Section 2:

- The posting of maintenance guarantee to remain valid and current until final acceptance; and
- All major components of the public construction of the development being В. complete and maintained to the extent that they do not present undue health, safety, and welfare hazards to the citizens; and
- C. Complete as built survey with thirty (30) days of acceptance.

That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption. Section 4:

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-31 is adopted.
