A RESOLUTION TO CONDITIONALLY ACCEPT AND BEGIN THE REQUIRED MINIMUM TWO AND ONE-HALF YEAR MAINTENANCE PERIOD FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WITH REGARD TO SHELLY'S RETREAT AT CARPENTERS MILL SUBDIVISION, SECTION 1, PART A, AS THE SAME IS DELINEATED UPON THE PLATS THEREOF RECORDED IN PLAT CABINET 4, SLIDE 55-55A, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO RECORDS.

WHEREAS, the public improvements of Shelly's Retreat at Carpenters Mill subdivision, Section 1, Part A are completed to the extent that it does not appear to present undue health, safety, and welfare hazards to the citizens.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That, pursuant to Section 1115.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Powell, the public improvements of Shelly's Retreat at Carpenters Mill subdivision, Section 1, Part A, as the same is delineated upon the plats of Morris Station of record in Plat Cabinet 4, slide 55-55A, at the Delaware County, Ohio Recorder, are conditionally accepted by the City of Powell.

Section 2: That this acceptance shall be conditioned upon:

- A. The posting of maintenance guarantee to remain valid and current until final acceptance; and
- B. All major components of the public construction of the development being complete and maintained to the extent that they do not present undue health, safety, and welfare hazards to the citizens.
- C. Receipt of recreation fees due per Powell City Code, Section 1105.06 as set forth in Invoice 2020-0002 and confirmed by the City Manager.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
