

## RESOLUTION 2021-26 Adopted December 7, 2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENT ACHIEVED IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN AFSCME, AFL-CIO, OHIO COUNCIL 8 AND THE CITY OF POWELL, OHIO, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO FINALIZE THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT NEGOTIATED BETWEEN THE PARTIES.

WHEREAS. the City of Powell, Ohio and AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Ohio Council 8 engaged in negotiations for a renewed contract and achieved a tentative agreement regarding full contract settlement for the bargaining unit; and

the tentative agreement achieved by the parties is hereby being presented to the WHEREAS. Council of the City of Powell, Ohio for approval consistent with Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That this Resolution authorizing the acceptance of the tentative agreement reached by the parties in collective bargaining between the City of Powell and AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Ohio Council 8 for the bargaining unit is hereby approved.

That the City Manager shall be authorized to take any and all necessary steps Section 2: and appropriate actions to finalize the collective bargaining agreement consistent with the terms of the negotiated tentative agreement.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by Section 4:
