

RESOLUTION 2022-39

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE DELAWARE COUNTY LAND REUTILIZATION CORPORATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RECEIPT OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT BUILDING DEMOLITION AND SITE REVITALIZATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development ("ODOD") created a Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program (the "Program") for the purpose of awarding grants for the demolition of commercial and residential buildings and revitalization of surrounding properties; and

WHEREAS, the Lead Entity for this program for Delaware County is the Land Bank, and is the responsible party with whom ODOD will execute a grant agreement for the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Lead Entity must then enter into subrecipient agreements with other local governments and grant recipients as part of the Program's application process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powell applied, and was given grant funding for, the demolition and revitalization of the structure at 35 N Liberty Street; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Program and receipt of this funding, the City must enter into a subrecipient agreement with the Delaware County Land Reutilization Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a subrecipient grant agreement for the Program and is further authorized to enter into any other agreements and do all things necessary and appropriate to secure the grant funding through the Program.

Section 2: This City Council finds and determines that all formal actions of the City Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
