

RESOLUTION 2022-41

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENTS ACHIEVED IN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BETWEEN FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC. AND THE CITY OF POWELL, OHIO, FOR THE OFFICERS' UNIT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO FINALIZE THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS NEGOTIATED BETWEEN THE PARTIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio and Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. engaged in negotiations for a renewed contract and achieved a tentative agreements regarding full contract settlement for the Officers' Unit for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the tentative agreements achieved by the parties was presented to the Council of the City of Powell, Ohio for approval consistent with Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That this Resolution authorizing the acceptance of the tentative agreement of a three (3%) wage increase effective January 1, 2023 reached by the parties in collective bargaining between the City of Powell and Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. for the bargaining unit consisting of Officers, is hereby approved.

Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any document or record to memorialize the consents authorized and approved by Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including the Charter of the City of Powell and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and affect immediately upon adoption.
