



RESOLUTION 2024-27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025-2027 WITH DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF POWELL CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), provides annual grants to entitled metropolitan cities and urban counties to develop viable urban communities; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG funds may be used for a wide range of items, many of which fit within the City Council's goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powell wishes to participate in the CDBG program through the Cooperation Agreement with Delaware County for fiscal years 2025-2027; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners has prepared a Cooperation Agreement that outlines the terms and responsibilities of both the County and the City/Village in administering CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the City Manager to execute the Cooperation Agreement on behalf of the City of Powell City Council to ensure continued eligibility for CDBG funding and to undertake essential community development activities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the Cooperation Agreement for Fiscal Years 2025-2027 with Delaware County, Ohio, on behalf of the City of Powell City Council.

Section 2: Council further hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager, the Director of Law, the Director of Finance, the Clerk of Council, or other appropriate officers of the City to take any other actions as may be appropriate to implement this Resolution without further legislation being required.




