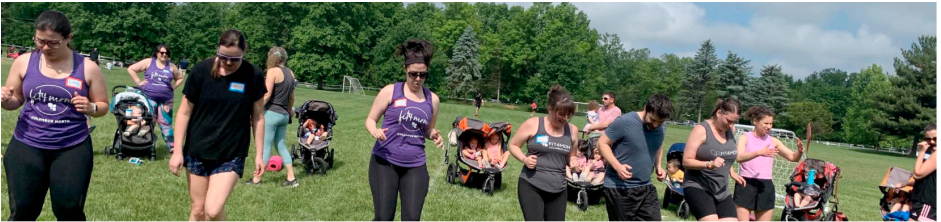

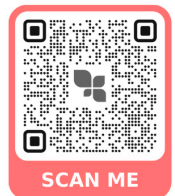

Registration Procedures

- Registration can be completed and processed online or in person.
- In person registration can take place between 8:30am-4:30pm. Please come prepared with a list of programs you are interested in participating in.
- Class fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. In person registration payment may be made by cash, check, or credit/debit card. Please make checks payable to “City of Powell.”
- Incomplete registration forms, incorrect payment, and/or failure to sign the liability waiver will result in your application being delayed.
- Registrations will be processed in the order they are received. You will be sent a receipt through email.
- Please be aware that enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- We will not contact you to confirm your registration and will contact you only if the class is canceled.

Residency Information

Programs and rentals offered by Powell Parks and Recreation have resident (R) and non-resident (NR) fees. Resident fees apply to those who live or work in the city limits of Powell, including all adult and child household members. These households and companies pay taxes that support the Powell Parks and Recreation Department and qualify for the resident rate for programs and rentals. All others pay the listed non-resident rate.

Please note that a Powell mailing address means your mail is processed by the Powell Post Office and does not align with municipal tax district residency boundaries.

General Information

Photo Release

By registering for, or attending, any City of Powell Parks and Recreation Department program, class, or event, you are agreeing to allow the publication of any photos taken of you and/or your child at any program, class, event or facility of the City of Powell Parks & Recreation Department.

Class Cancellation

The City of Powell Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel classes due to low enrollment and/or other unforeseen circumstances. In the case of a program/class cancellation, you will be notified and issued a full refund in the form of a check or to the credit card used for purchase. Refunds take approximately four weeks to process. When a program/class is canceled due to low enrollment, every effort will be made to notify you 48 hours in advance via e-mail. Prepare to attend each class unless you are notified by a City of Powell employee or the program instructor.

Refunds

Participant-requested refunds are subject to a processing fee. For courses less than \$50 there is a flat \$5 processing fee, and for course fees over \$51 there is a 10% processing fee. Refunds will be granted only when requested no later than five days prior to the first class meeting. Since decisions to maintain classes are based on the enrollment at the first session, no refunds are granted after the first session. In the case of maximum class enrollment or class cancellation, you will be granted a full check refund. Please allow four weeks for processing all refunds. Refunds for camps may incur additional fees. All in person payments will be refunded in the form of a check.

Anticipate to participate. Register early.

Waiting until the last minute could mean the program you are interested in will be canceled. In order for a class to survive, we must have at least the minimum number of registrants 48 hours prior to the start of the first class. Attempting to enroll on the day classes are set to begin will not save the class. PLEASE REGISTER EARLY.

Reservations

Park Shelters and Athletic Fields

The City of Powell has several areas that can be reserved for community functions. Athletic field and park shelter reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a maximum of two 90-minute reservations per week per group for athletic fields. Park shelters are available on a per hour basis. All reservations are subject to approval by the Parks & Recreation Manager.

A CD, an MP3 downloadable version of the song collection, a songbook, a new family music development booklet, a Music Together growth chart, access to the Music Together Family Music Zone, and the Hello Everybody app are included! Each week, a trained Music Together instructor leads the class in singing, dancing, and playing songs that range from tender lullabies to boisterous jams using child-friendly percussion instruments. Our award-winning music, illustrated songbook, and other print and online resources will help you continue the music-making fun at home and nurture your child's musical growth—even if you don't think of yourself as a great singer or dancer. This community-based drop-off program will be running the duration of the school year! We will have a fall session (September-December) and a spring session (January-May). Children enrolled in the fall session have first opportunity to register for spring session. We are a continuous enrollment program and welcome all young learners to Powell RecSchool at any time!
