**RESOLUTION 2015-03**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE SMOKY ROW EXPRESS #30 BUS ROUTE.**

**WHEREAS,** COTA Route #30 provides an alternative transportation option for residents who travel to and from work and services; and

**WHEREAS,** public transportation aids in the reduction of traffic congestion; and

**WHEREAS,** the Route #30 line is the closest public transportation option that serves Powell residents and those in the surrounding community; and

**WHEREAS,** COTA has indicated its plan to discontinue the Route #30 line; and

**WHEREAS,** discontinuation of the Route #30 line will place a hardship on the Powell residents who depend on this transportation service;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the City Council of Powell supports the continued operation of the Smoky Row Express Route #30 and urges COTA to continue its operation.

**Section 2:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.



**Section 3:** That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.
