ORDINANCE 2015-23

Adopted May 19, 2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO THE FEE SCHEDULE OF THE CITY OF POWELL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council has previously established a fee schedule within the City of Powell, as authorized by adoption of Ordinance 2014-56; and

WHEREAS, the Council has subsequently determined that certain fees need to be revised and that certain fees are not addressed within the schedule; and

WHEREAS, Council accordingly desires to update the fee schedule of the City of Powell as proposed in the revised fee schedule;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby approves and adopts the revised fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to provide services in an efficient and equitable manner; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

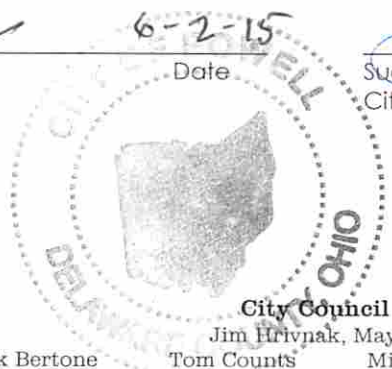
