

City of Powell, Ohio ORDINANCE 2016-03

Adopted January 19, 2016

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUBDIVISION PLAT FOR POWELL GRAND, BY SAWMILL SELDOM SEEN, LLC FOR THE PROPERTY SOUTH OF SELDOM SEEN ROAD, WEST OF THE CSX RAILROAD.

WHEREAS, Sawmill Seldom Seen, LLC submitted for approval a plat for the property south of Seldom Seen Road, west of the CSX railroad; and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2016, the Powell Planning & Zoning Commission approved said plat for Powell Grand; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that approval of the subdivision plat is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Powell;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the subdivision plat for Powell Grand, south of Seldom Seen Road, west of the CSX railroad, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A", is approved by the Council for the City of Powell, subject to the following conditions:

- That all easements and lot numbers appear on the plat as need to be required by the City Engineer.
- 2. That any possible conflicting overlapping easements be clarified by the applicant to Staff.
- 3. That all other items as needed be added or removed from the plat as directed by Staff prior to signature.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.
