ORDINANCE 2016-37

Adopted August 16, 2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE DELAWARE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING A MULTI-USE PATHWAY NORTH OF RUTHERFORD ROAD, WEST OF SAWMILL PARKWAY AND EAST OF TRICIA PRICE DRIVE WITHIN THE COUNTY'S RIGHT OF WAY.

WHEREAS, the City identified the need for improved pedestrian and bike path connectivity for residents around the City and surrounding county; and

WHEREAS, the City has proposed the extension of a Multi-Use Pathway north of Rutherford Road, west of Sawmill Parkway and east of Tricia Price Drive that will be partially located in Delaware County's right-of-way in the unincorporated territory of Liberty Township; and

WHEREAS, the City, Delaware County and Liberty Township desire to enter into an agreement for the ongoing maintenance of the Multi-Use Pathway north of Rutherford Road, west of Sawmill Parkway and east of Tricia Price Drive in order to offer consistent and efficient maintenance of the pathways to provide for the public health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, for the purposes of this agreement, the City, Delaware County and Liberty Township agree that the City will be responsible for maintaining all pathway improvements for an indefinite period and until otherwise agreed upon;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Multi-Use Pathway Maintenance Agreement with the Delaware County Commissioners and the Liberty Township Trustees, in a form substantially similar to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.
