A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE PRIMARY INSPECTION AREA TO REPAIR OR REPLACE SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF POWELL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Powell, City Council is required to approve the primary inspection area for purposes of the annual sidewalk repair program; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer proposes the primary inspection area on the maps attached hereto as Exhibits "A" "B" & "C" and incorporated herein by reference;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Engineer is directed to conduct a survey of sidewalks, integral approaches/aprons and related areas which are in need of repair or replacement within the primary inspection area for the 2017 Sidewalk Program as identified on the map attached hereto as Exhibits "A" "B" & "C" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-02 was adopted.


