RESOLUTION 2017-28

Adopted October 17, 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SEWER MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH DELAWARE COUNTY AND LIBERTY TOWNSHIP FOR STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS INSTALLED UNDER HUNTER'S BEND IN THE RESERVE AT SCIOTO GLEN DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Delaware County Commissioners, and the Liberty Township Trustees desire to provide a consistent, efficient, and ongoing maintenance of the storm sewer improvements which straddle the boundary between the City of Powell and Liberty Township under Hunter's Bend in the Reserve at Scioto Glen development for the public health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That consistent, efficient, and ongoing maintenance of the storm sewer improvements which straddle the boundary between the City and Township under Hunter's Bend in the Reserve at Scioto Glen development is hereby declared necessary for the public health, safety, convenience and welfare of the public.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to cooperate with any necessary agencies and enter into a Storm Sewer Maintenance Agreement with Delaware County and Liberty Township in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.

By unanimous consent, Resolution 2017-28 was adopted.
