ORDINANCE 2017-42

Adopted August 15, 2017

AN ORDINANCE REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE PARK AT SELDOM SEEN ROAD IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City had advertised for bids for the construction of Phases 1-3 of Seldom Seen Park; and

WHEREAS, the City opened and publically read bids for this project on July 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, all bids received pursuant to said solicitation are either in excess of the funds appropriated and anticipated for the cost of the construction of the park or do not meet the bid specifications and Council has determined that all bids should be rejected.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That all bids received by the City of Powell pursuant to the solicitation for bids for the construction of Phases 1-3 of Seldom Seen Park which bid results are attached hereto as Exhibit A, are hereby rejected in their entirety.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

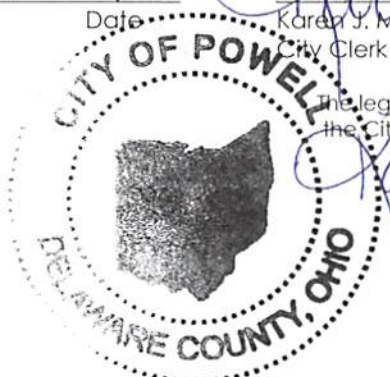


