I. KEEP POWELL MOVING

II. CAPITAL UPDATES

- a. Murphy Parkway Extension – the gravity wall is being placed next week. The project is on schedule and the roadway is slated to open this fall.
- b. Murphy Pedestrian Crossing – no update to report.
- c. Grace Drive Traffic Signals – City Engineer Chris Huber reported they received a preliminary cost estimate for the traffic signals.
- d. Olentangy Queue Cutter – The queue cutter was activated today. The queue cutter will continue to be monitored.
- e. SR 750/Sawmill Parkway – The Ohio Department of Transportation is on schedule to complete the project in late August.
- f. Park at Seldom Seen – Staff just received the phasing schedule.
- g. Lechler Building – Staff plans on bringing forward a proposal and cost estimate to clean up the appearance of the Lechler Building.

Communications Director Megan Canavan reported that Saperstein & Associates should be concluding the survey process later this week. Marty Saperstein will bring forward a report of the survey findings sometime this summer.
