AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2016.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2016 in accordance with the information attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2016 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

Appropriate:

1. The City's Powell Festival planning committee has been gathering donations to offset the costs associated with presenting the festival. We are requesting to increase the appropriations for the Powell Festival to allow for the spending of the funds that have been collected through donations to cover the additional costs.

As of 5/31/2016 donations collected amount to \$53,250.

Parks and Recreation Programming, Operating Expenditures \$10,000.00

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.
