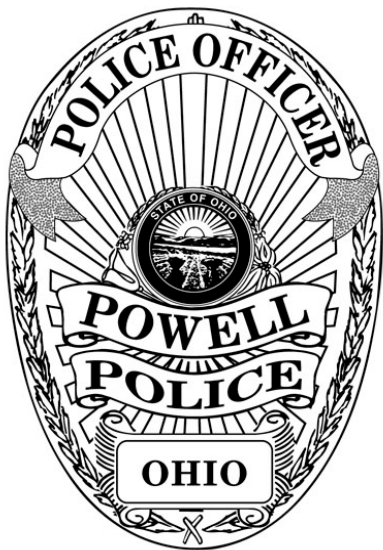

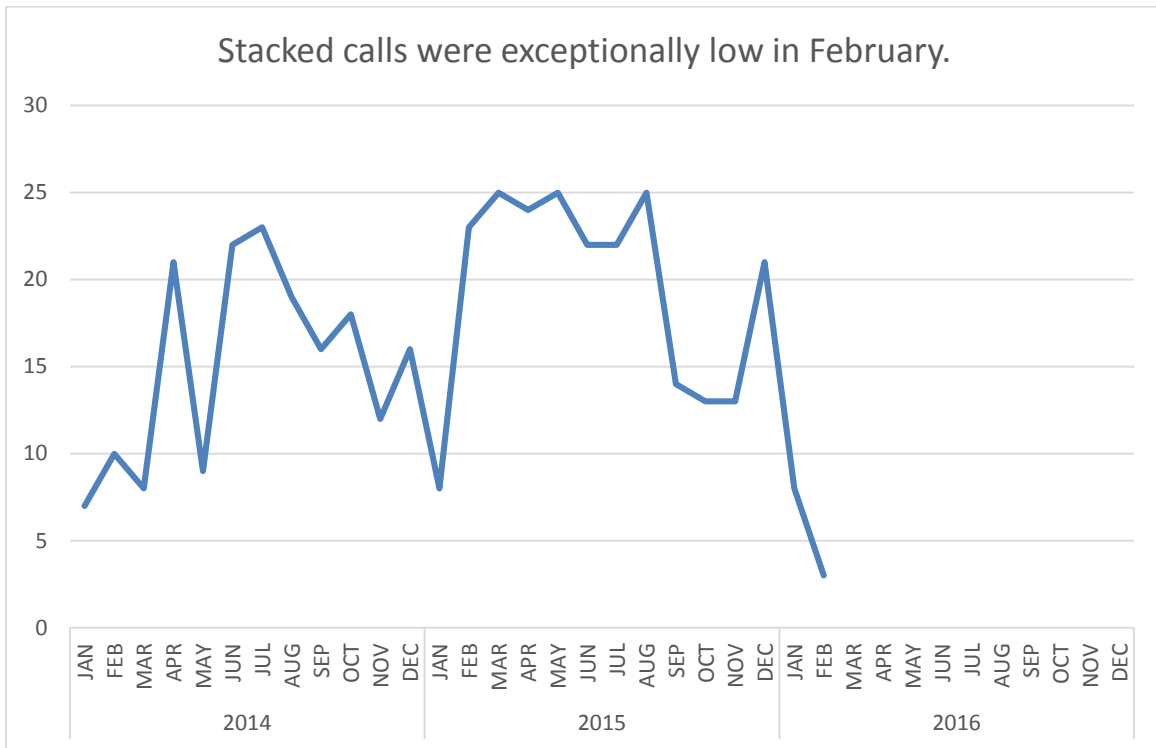

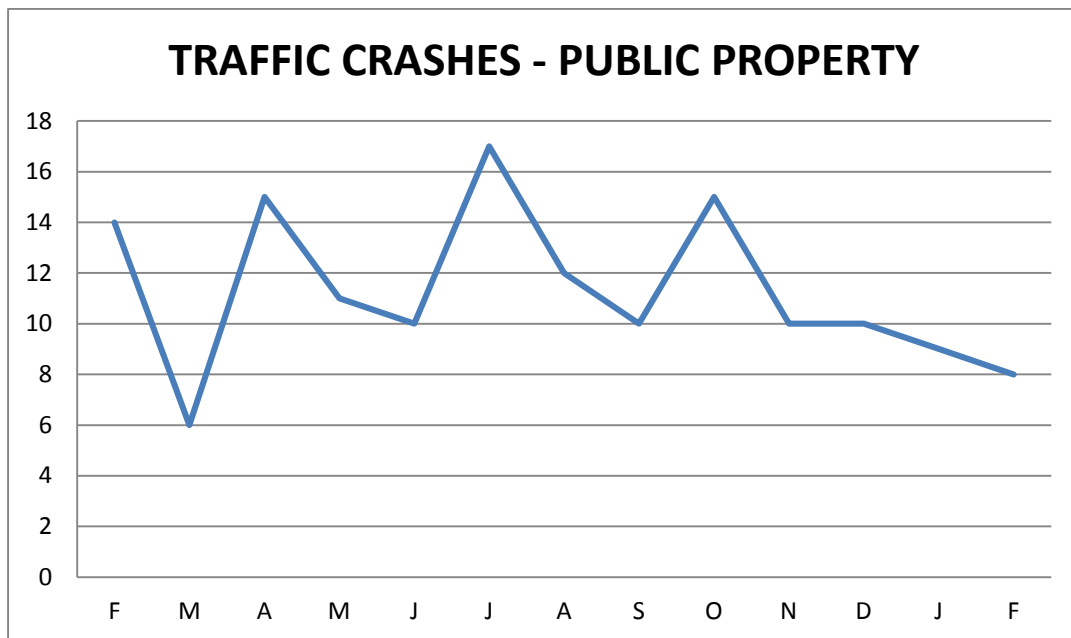
TRAINING

13-MONTH PATTERN OF CRASHES

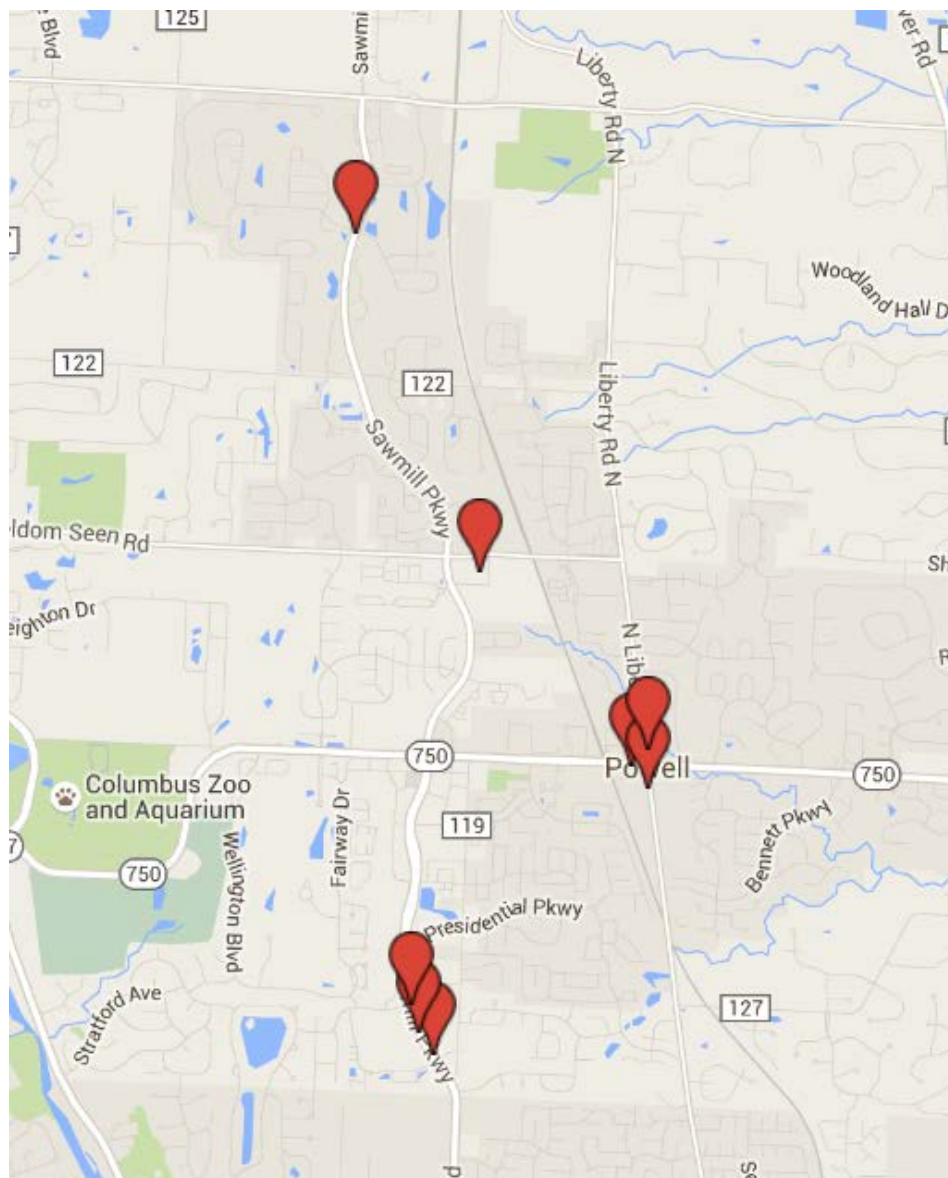


TRAFFIC CRASHES – PUBLIC PROPERTY

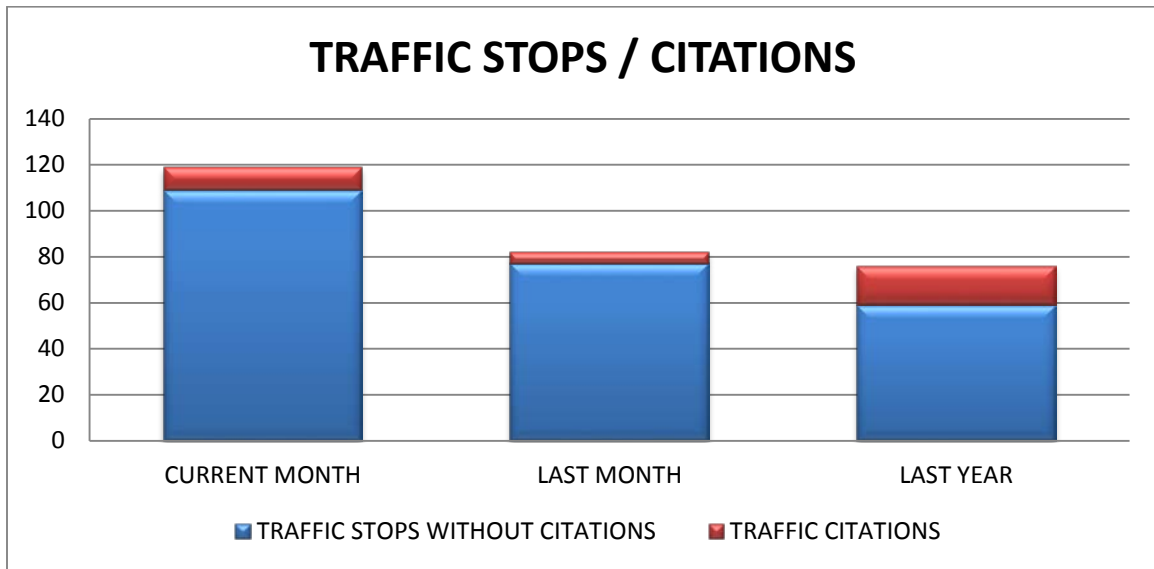
