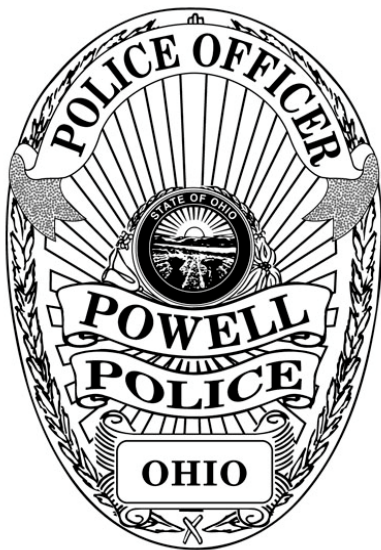

Traffic Stops | Multiple citations and warnings were issued for illegal left turns at the four corners during prohibited hours.

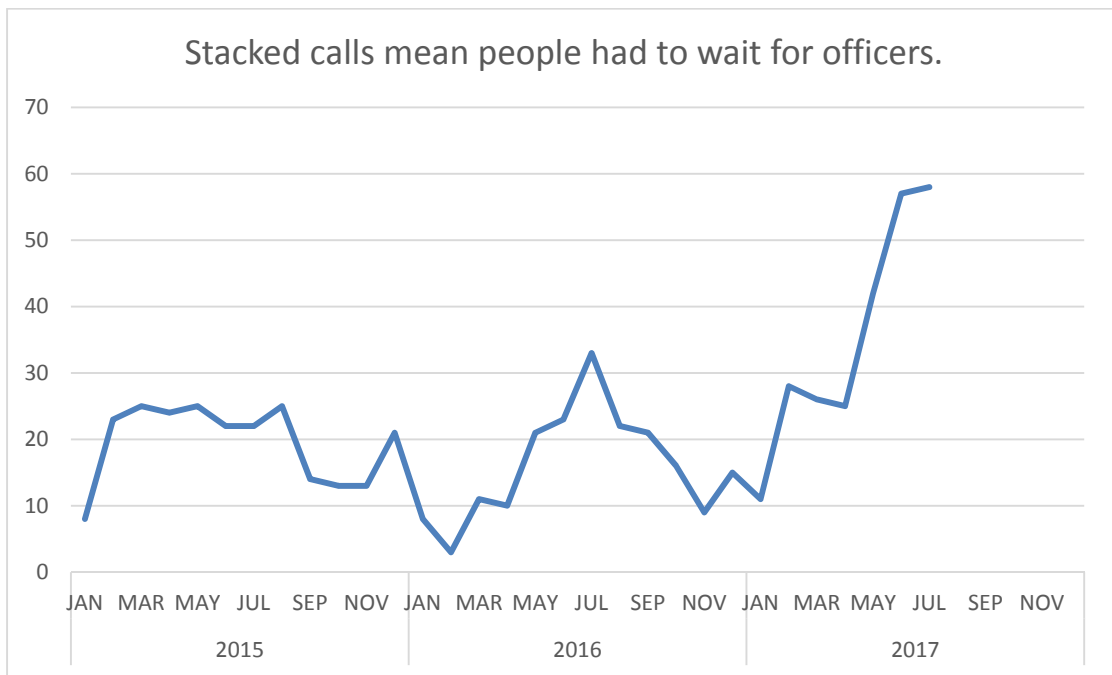

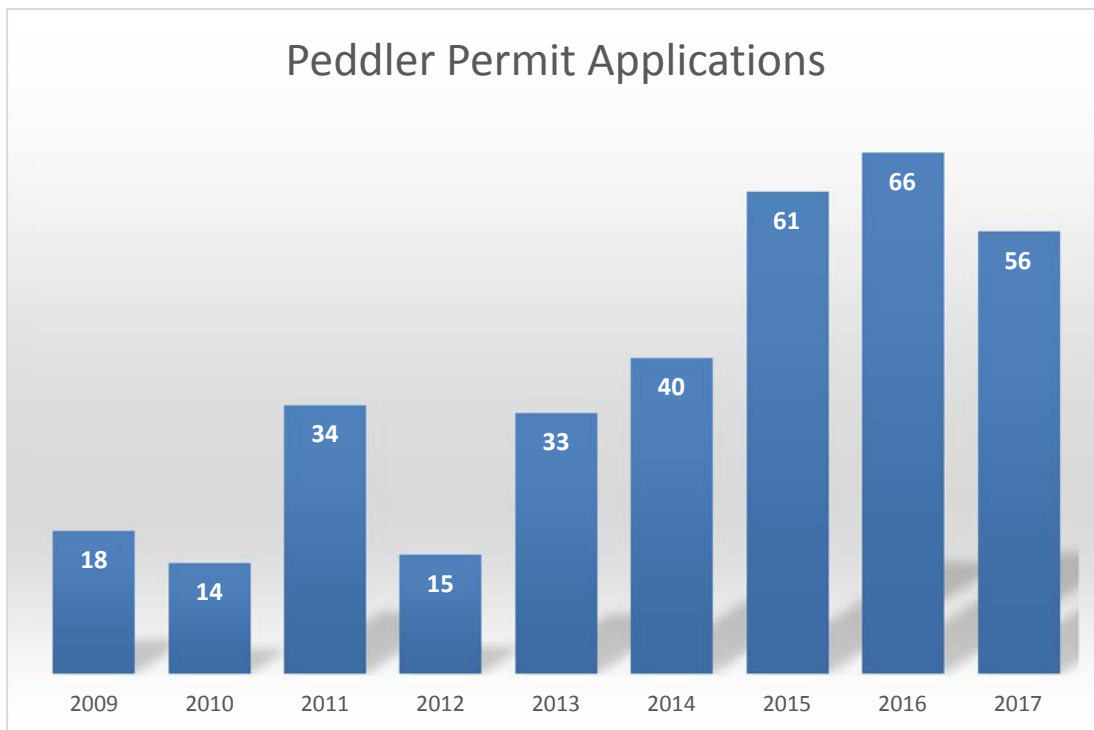

The 85th Percentile means that 85% of all vehicles were traveling at this speed or slower.

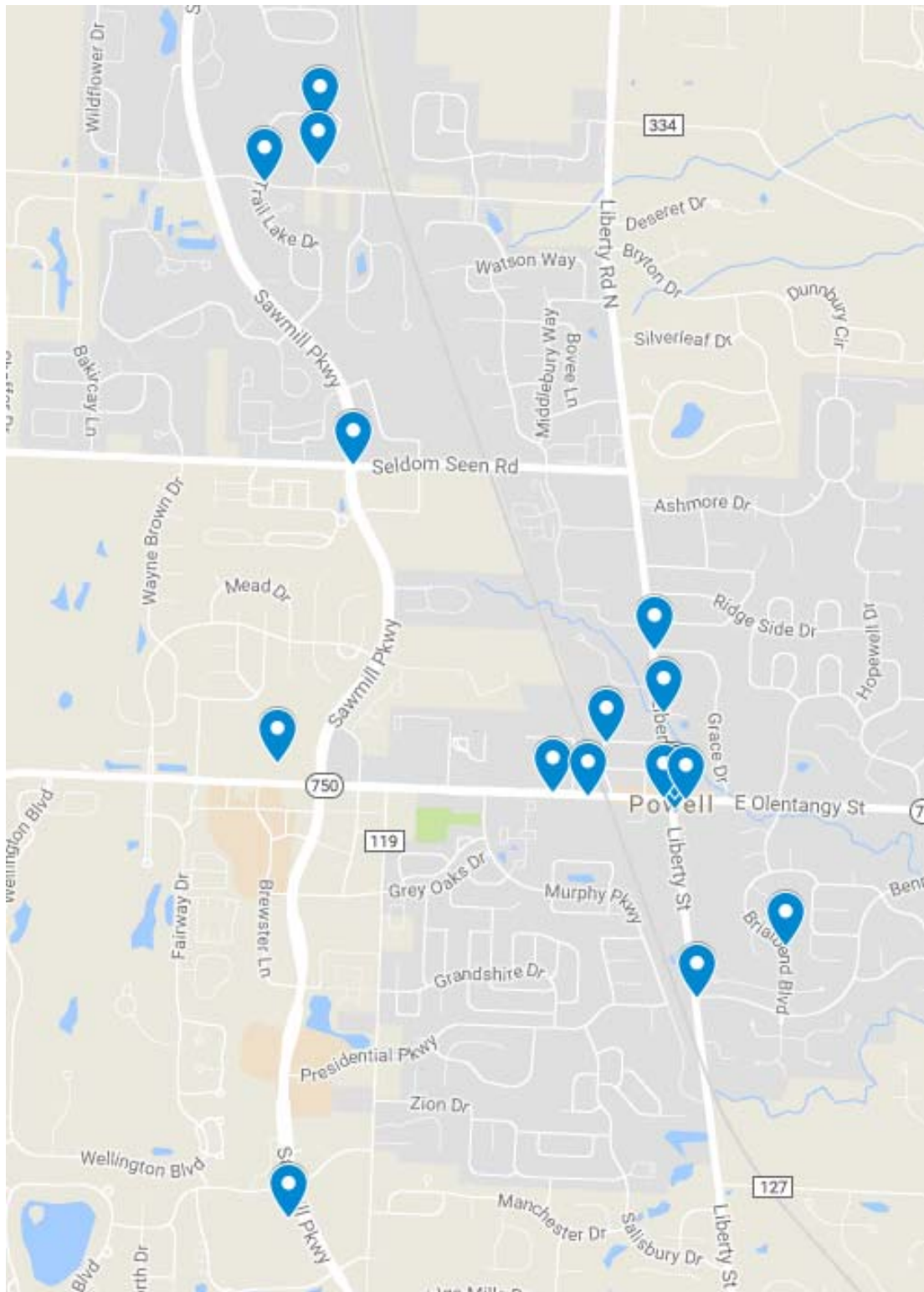
TRAFFIC CRASHES – PUBLIC & PRIVATE PROPERTY

- 7/1/2017 **OVI | Injury** | Driver of Unit 1 failed to maintain control of the vehicle causing it to leave the roadway and strike a tree. Unit 1 was arrested.
- 7/3/2017 **Failure to Yield | Injury** | Unit 1 was traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy. and Unit 2 was executing a left turn to go southbound on Sawmill Pkwy. Both units collided in the intersection of Sawmill Pkwy. and Seldom Seen Rd. Fault could not be determined due to both drivers advising they had a green light to proceed. Unit 2 was cited for No Ops.
- 7/5/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 was attempting to park in the private lot at the Powell Target and struck Unit 2, which was parked. Unit 1 left the scene without reporting the crash.

- 7/6/2017 **ACDA** | Units 1 and 2 were eastbound on SR 750. Unit 2 stopped for traffic. Unit 1 was unable to stop and struck Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/6/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 struck a pole while making a right turn to go east on SR 750 from S. Liberty St. Unit 1 then fled the scene prior to law enforcement arriving. Unit 1 was identified and cited.
- 7/7/2017 **ACDA** | Unit 1 and 2 were headed southbound on S. Liberty St. Unit 2 stopped in traffic at the direction of a police officer and was rear ended by Unit 1.
- 7/7/2017 **Hit-Skip** | *Injury* | While stopped at a stop sign, Unit 2 was struck by Unit 1 in the rear. Unit 1 failed to stop and struck Unit 2.
- 7/8/2017 **OVI** | While driving northbound on North Liberty Street, Unit 1 ran off the road to the right, struck a guard rail and overturned. The vehicle came to rest in the intersection of North Liberty and Sharp Street. Unit 1 was arrested.
- 7/9/2017 **ACDA** | *Injury* | While eastbound on Rutherford Rd. Unit 1 struck Unit 2 from behind. At the time of the collision, Unit 2 had slowed or stopped in order to make a left turn to go north onto Trail Lake Dr. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/11/2017 **Driving on Sidewalk** | Unit 1 was turning right onto S.R. 750 from S. Liberty St. Unit 1 went on the sidewalk and struck a traffic light pole with a rear passenger side tire while completing the turn. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/15/2017 **Marked Lanes** | *Injury* | Units 2 and 3 were westbound on Case St. at Depot St. Unit 1 entered the roadway from a private drive near Case and Depot St. Unit 1 failed to maintain its lane and struck Units 2 and 3.
- 7/15/2017 **Backing** | Unit 1 and Unit 2 were backing out of the parking spaces at 4000 West Powell Road. The driver of Unit 2 reports that she started to back out first and after she was in the drive area the other vehicle backed out and struck her vehicle.

- 7/18/2017 **Failure to Yield** | Unit 2 was northbound on Guard-Well St. Unit 1 was pulled over to the right on Guard-Well St. As Unit 2 passed, Unit 1 pulled onto Guard-Well St. and struck Unit 2.
- 7/21/2017 **Failure to Control** | *Injury* | Unit 1 was traveling eastbound on Rutherford Road and turned north onto Flagg View Drive. The vehicle drifted to the left side of the roadway, went over the curb, and struck a tree in front of a residence. The collision caused the vehicle to overturn, coming to a final rest on the driver's side of the vehicle. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/25/2017 **ACDA** | Unit 1, 2, and 3 were all traveling north on S. Liberty St. Unit 2 and Unit 3 were stopped in traffic, when Unit 1 struck Unit 2 in the rear, Unit 2 was then pushed into the rear of Unit 3. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/27/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 was traveling northbound on Liberty Street as it approached the intersection of East Olentangy Street. The vehicle turned east on East Olentangy Street, but was unable to clear its lane of travel. The vehicle's trailer went over the curb in the south eastern part of the intersection and damaged a pole. The vehicle proceeded to drive away without stopping to assess the damage. Unit 1 was identified and cited.
- 7/28/2017 **ACDA** | Unit 1 and 2 were Northbound on Liberty Street just South of SR750. The driver of Unit 1 reported that his foot slipped off the brake and he ran into the rear of the Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/29/2017 **Failure to Control** | Unit 1 was eastbound on Briarbend Blvd. Unit 1 failed to use reasonable control, ran off the roadway right, struck a tree and struck a fire hydrant. Unit 1 was cited.
- 7/29/2017 **ACDA** | Unit 1 and 2 were both headed eastbound on SR 750 near 146 W. Olentangy. Unit 2 was stopped in traffic when Unit 1 failed to have assured clear distance ahead and rear ended Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
