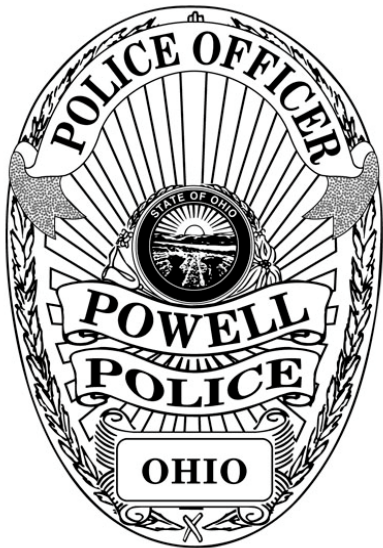

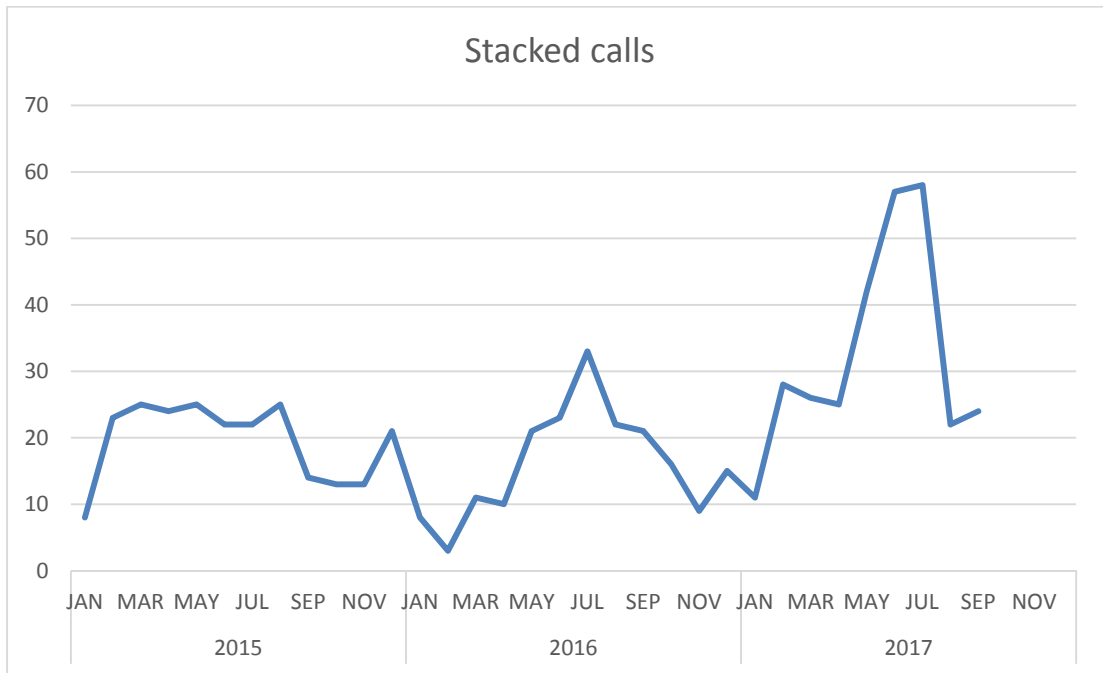
**Disturbing a Lawful Meeting** | Police were asked to escort an individual from a City Council meeting.

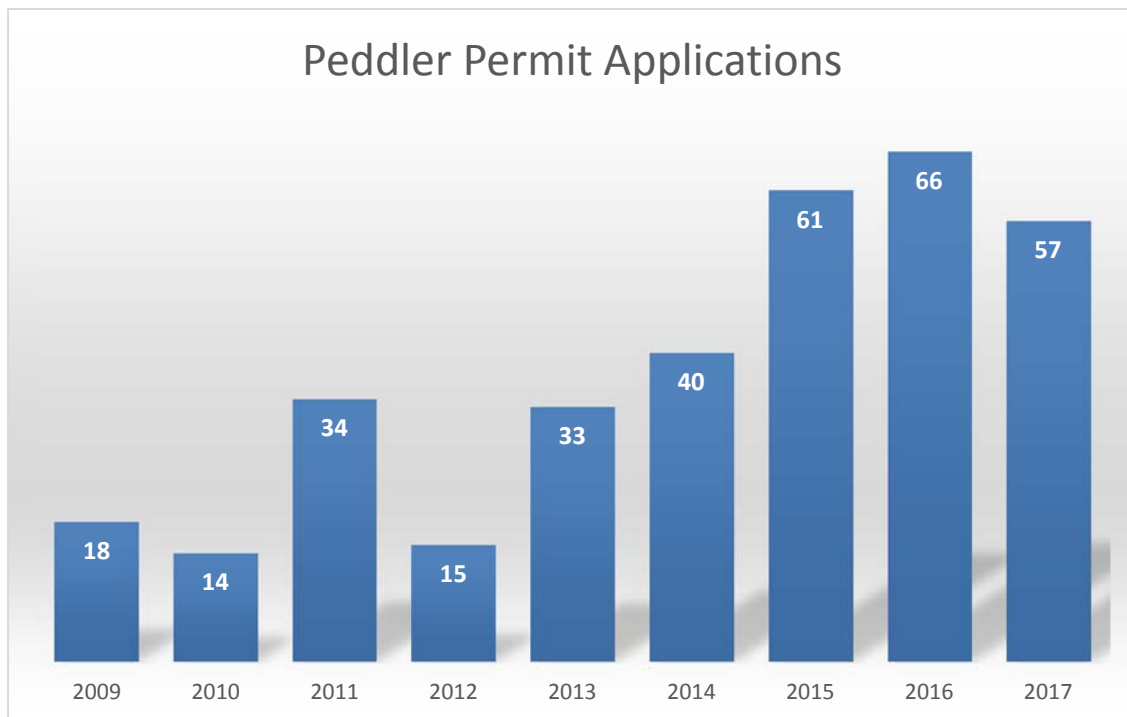

## TRAFFIC CRASHES – PUBLIC & PRIVATE PROPERTY

- 9/11/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 2 was parked facing southbound on Village Club Dr. Unit 1 struck the mirror of Unit 2 and left the area without reporting the crash.
- 9/12/2017 **Failure to Control** | Unit 1 and Unit 2 (both construction vehicles) were facing Northbound on Sunrise Ridge Place. Unit 1 was attempting to maneuver around Unit 2. While attempting this the operator of Unit 2 got into the cab to attempt to move the truck. The door being opened of Unit 2 caused the two vehicles to come into contact with each other. Unit 1 was the only vehicle in motion and therefore struck Unit 2.
- 9/17/2017 **Failure to Control** | Unit 1 entered the alley to the parking lot of 28 North Liberty Street. While turning right into a

handicapped parking spot Unit 1 struck a curb with the right side of the vehicle.

- 9/20/2017 **Failure to Yield** | Unit 2 was Eastbound on Seldom Seen Road, approaching Sheridan Street. Unit 2 entered the left turn lane to turn North onto Sheridan Street. Unit 1 was Southbound on Sheridan street, waiting to turn left to go East on Seldom Seen Road. Unit 2 began to make a left turn onto Sheridan Street while Unit 1 failed to yield and struck Unit 2 in the side.
- 9/21/2017 **ACDA** | Unit 1 and Unit 2 were westbound on SR750 in the area of 60 East Olentangy. Unit 2 stopped for traffic. As Unit 1 came up the hill she did not see the stopped traffic. Unit 1 struck the rear of Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/21/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 2 was parked at 10241 Sawmill Pkwy facing northbound. Unit 1, an unknown vehicle, struck Unit 2 while it was unoccupied, and left the scene.
- 9/23/2017 **ACDA** | While traveling westbound on SR 750 and waiting at a red light at the Murphy Pkwy intersection, Unit 2 was struck from behind by Unit 1. At the time of the collision, Unit 1 was also traveling westbound on SR 750 and failed to maintain an assured clear distance ahead. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/25/2017 **Failure to Control** | Unit 1 was stopped at the traffic light westbound on SR 750 at Grace Dr. As Unit 1 turned north onto Grace Dr. they failed to use reasonable control, ran off the roadway right, and struck a street sign. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/26/2017 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 struck Unit 2 while leaving the parking lot located in front of 4046 W. Powell Rd. At the time of the collision Unit 2 was parked in a spot directly in front of Unit 1.
- 9/29/2017 **Backing** | Unit 1 backed into Unit 2 while stopped at a light at Seldom Seen Road and Sawmill Parkway. Unit 1 and 2 were in the left turn lane and Unit 1 stated he realized he needed to be in the right turn lane, at which point he placed the vehicle in reverse and did not look before backing up. Unit 1 was cited.
