I. 2018 COMMUNITY ATTITUDE SURVEY – MARTY SAPERSTEIN

The Committee met with Marty Saperstein of Columbus-based Saperstein & Associates to discuss the 2018 Community Attitude Survey. The City of Powell has worked with Saperstein & Associates to conduct Community Attitude Surveys every two years since 2008. Saperstein & Associates conducts a phone survey with a cross-section of approximately 400 residents. Each phone survey typically takes approximately 15 minutes. Residents are asked about a variety of topics pertaining to Powell, from what they like most about living in the City to what public officials should consider to be top priorities for the future.

ACTION ITEM: The Committee would like to move forward with conducting the 2018 Community Attitude Survey in February and recommends doing a phone survey again. Committee members have been asked to bring forward concepts and ideas of survey questions to their December meeting.
