Review of Proposal by VSI for a Strategic Business Development Plan and Housing Market Study: Mr. Betz reviewed the proposal of Vogt Strategic Insights for a strategic business development plan and housing market study for the Development Department. This plan is one of the next steps recommended by the Comprehensive Plan in an effort to utilize City resources more efficiently. This plan will help the City determine what it should be doing and looking at within the community moving forward to attract businesses and housing. The Powell CIC is also interested in the study because it goes along with their core purpose and, therefore, is willing to share the expense of this study.

ACTION ITEM: Committee approved moving forward jointly with the Powell CIC to contract with VSI for the strategic business development plan and housing market study with the CIC picking up 60% of the cost and the City 40% of the cost. Assuming Powell CIC approves the funding at is next meeting, an appropriation will be presented to Council at its April 20th meeting.
