

TRAFFIC CRASHES


- 7/1/18 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 struck a mailbox, breaking the mailbox post. Unit 1 driver did not stop to report the crash.
- 7/1/18 **ACDA** | *Injury* | At the time of the collision, Unit 1 and Unit 2 were traveling eastbound on SR 750. Unit 2 slowed for a braking vehicle which was in front of it, and upon doing so, Unit 1 struck Unit 2 from behind due to not leaving an assured clear distance ahead.
- 7/7/18 **Backing** | Unit 1 backed out of a parking space and then proceeded to drive forward and struck a parked car that was in the same row.
- 7/7/18 **ACDA** | Unit 2 and Unit 3 were stopped in traffic eastbound on SR 750 at Liberty St. Unit 1 was behind Unit

2 also eastbound. Unit 1 failed to use assured clear distance ahead and struck Unit 2, pushing it into Unit 3.

- 7/8/18 Failure to Yield | *Injury* | Unit 2 was northbound on Sawmill Pkwy. and Unit 1 was westbound on Trail Lake Dr. at Sawmill Pkwy. Unit 1 failed to yield the right of way at a stop sign and pulled onto Sawmill Pkwy. and was struck by Unit 2.
- 7/10/18 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 was northbound on Winter Hill Pl. and struck the mailbox at 306. It is unknown which part of the vehicle caused the damage to the mailbox, as Unit 1 left the scene without reporting the crash.
- 7/11/18 **ACDA** | *Injury* | Unit 2 was stopped in traffic. Unit 1 was unable to stop in time and struck Unit 2 in the rear.
- 7/11/18 **ACDA** | *Injury* | Units 1 and 2 were eastbound on SR 750. Unit 2 stopped for traffic. Unit 1 failed to stop and struck Unit 2.
- 7/11/18 **ACDA** | Unit 2 was stopping in traffic, traveling eastbound on SR 750. Unit 1 failed to maintain a safe distance ahead and struck Unit 2 in the rear.
- 7/12/18 **Backing** | Unit 1 was backing in the parking lot behind 22 S. Liberty. Unit 1 stated he did not see Unit 2 behind him and backed into Unit 2. Unit 2 stated she was waiting for a parking spot to open and was stopped in the parking lot when Unit 1 backed into her vehicle.
- 7/16/18 ACDA | Units 1 and 2 were eastbound on SR 750 near Valley Run Dr. Unit 2 stopped for traffic and was struck in the rear by Unit 1.
- 7/19/18 **ACDA** | Unit 1 and Unit 2 were at the traffic light waiting to turn left. The driver of Unit 1 struck the rear of Unit 2.

- 7/26/18 **Failure to Control** | Unit 2 was parked in the lot of 4000 W. Powell. Unit 1 pulled from a parking space and struck Unit 2.
- 7/26/18 **Tree** | Unit 1 was traveling eastbound, when a tree from 24 E. Olentangy St. fell into the roadway, striking Unit 1.
- 7/29/18 ACDA | The driver of Unit 2 was stopped on Bunker Lane at Seldom Seen waiting to make a right-hand turn to head east onto Seldom Seen Road. The driver of Unit 1 was stopped behind Unit 2. The driver of Unit 2 started to move but then stopped again due to an approaching car eastbound on Seldom Seen Road. The driver of Unit 1 struck Unit 2.
- 7/30/18 ACDA | *Injury* | The driver of Unit 2 stopped at the railroad crossing heading west on Seldom Seen Road. The driver of Unit 1 did not realize he had stopped and rear-ended Unit 2.
