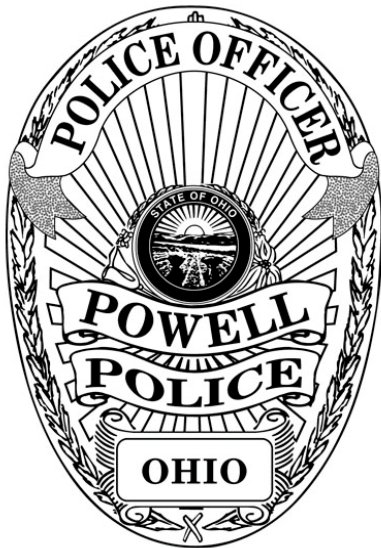

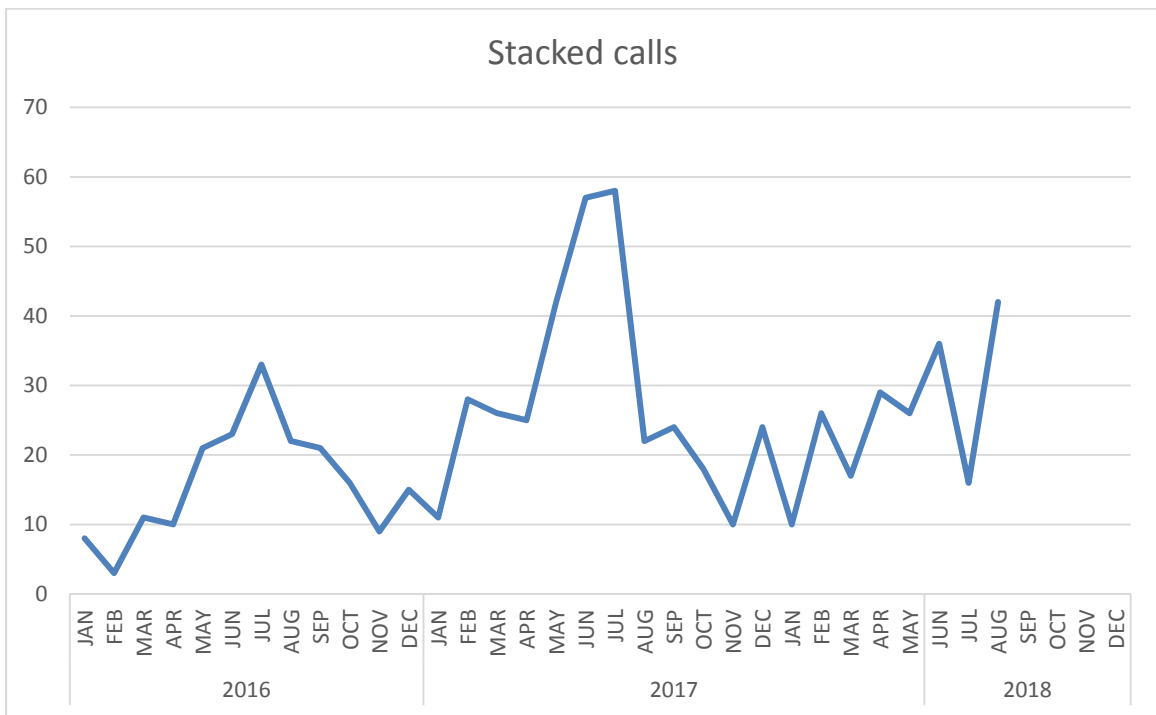
ATM Skimmer | A skimmer was discovered on an ATM at a bank on Sawmill Parkway. The case is under investigation.

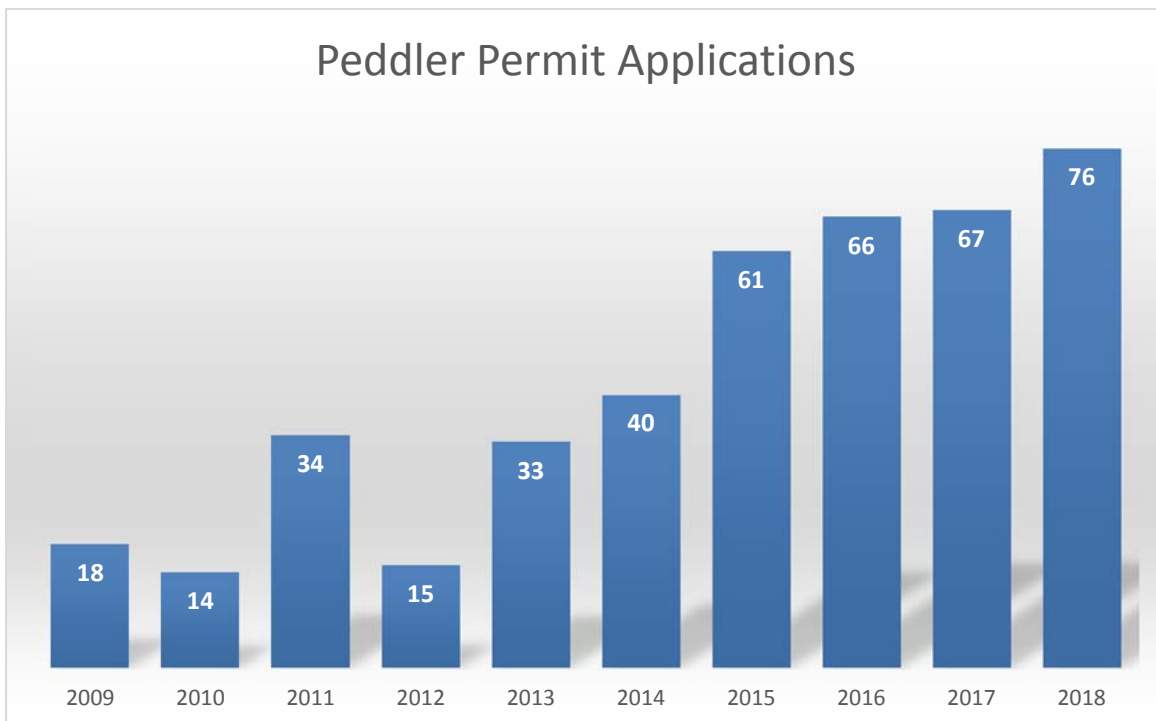

TRAINING

In August the department conducted 192 hours of training to include **Pursuit Review, Use of Force Review, High Threat CQB Patrol Instructor, Basic Rifle Operator, and Narcotics Identification Course.**

TRAFFIC SURVEYS (STEALTH STAT)

The City of Powell Police Department uses this data to assign officers for selective enforcement efforts.

Average Speed: The average speed of all vehicles registered by the Stealth Stat device.

85th Percentile: 85 percent of all vehicles were at this speed or slower.

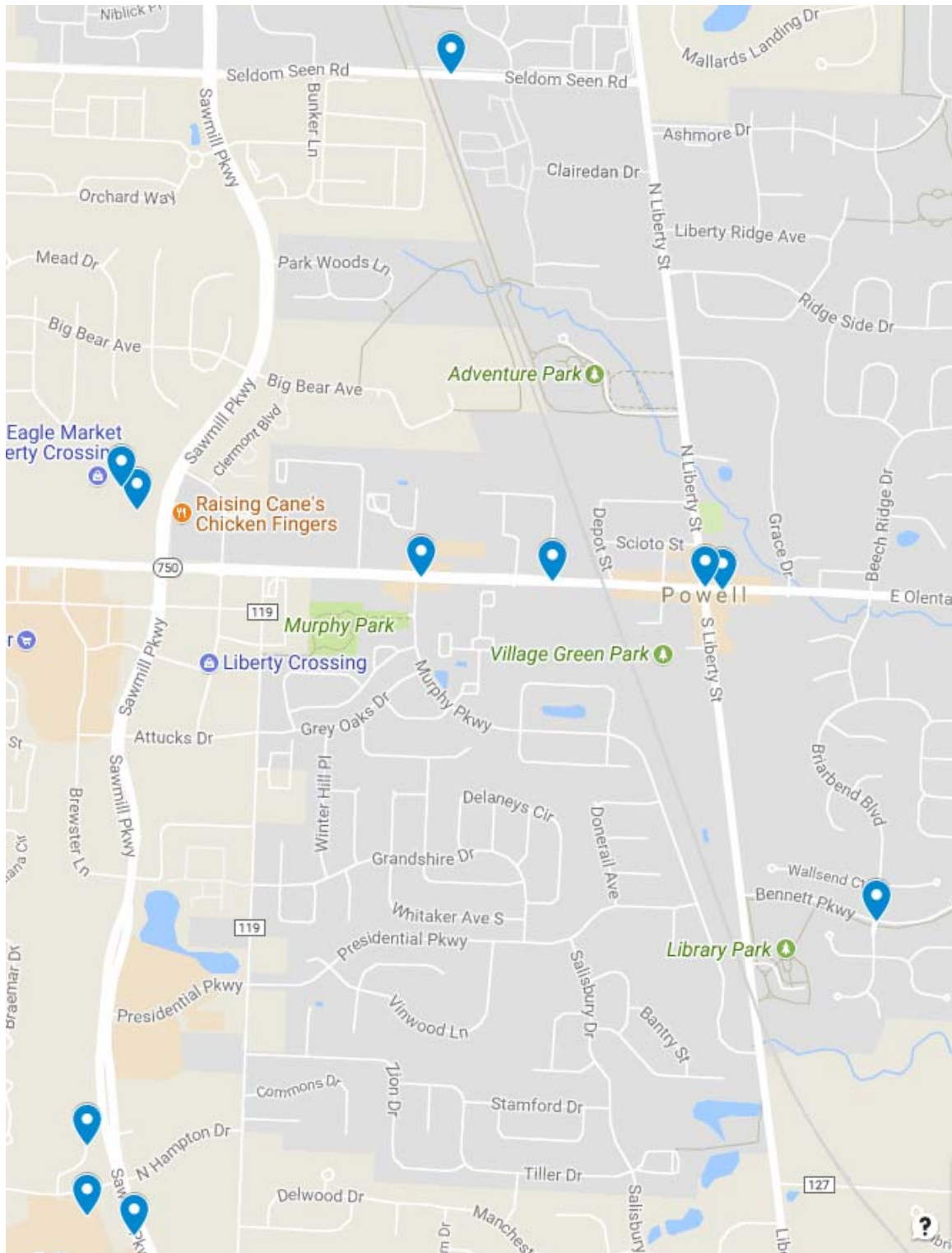

TRAFFIC CRASHES

- 8/2/18 **ACDA** | *Injury* | Units 1 and 2 were both traveling eastbound on SR 750. Unit 2 stopped in traffic and Unit 1 failed to keep an assured clear distance ahead and struck Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
- 8/4/18 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 2 was parked in a parking spot. Unit 1 pulled into the spot next to Unit 2 and struck the left rear area. Unit 1 reversed and then moved to another area of the lot before leaving the scene.
- 8/4/18 **Backing** | Unit 1 and Unit 2 were both located at 9590 Sawmill Pkwy. (Get Go Gas). Unit 1 went into reverse and struck Unit 2 in the front left. Unit 2 was parked in a no parking zone.
- 8/7/18 **Backing** | Units 1 and 2 were in the lot of 15 E. Olentangy. Units 1 and 2 each started to back from their respective parking stalls. Units 1 and 2 made contact in the parking lot.
- 8/10/18 **ACDA** | Units 1 and 2 were eastbound on SR 750. After passing Lincoln Street, Unit 2 stopped for traffic and was struck in the rear by Unit 1. Unit 1 was cited.
- 8/10/18 **ACDA** | Unit 3 was stopped for a traffic light at SR 750 and Liberty Rd, heading westbound. Unit 2 was slowing down for the same traffic light when Unit 1 struck Unit 2 in the rear and pushed Unit 2 into the rear of Unit 3.
- 8/13/18 **Fail to Control** | *Injury* | Unit 1 was traveling from north to south in the Wedgewood Urgent Care parking lot when they struck a curb, stop sign, and a tree for an unknown reason.
- 8/13/18 **Hit-Skip** | *Injury* | Unit 1 was northbound on Bennett Pkwy at Briarbend Blvd. At the intersection, Unit 1 struck a pedestrian then fled the scene, continuing northbound.

- 8/17/18 **Fail to Control** | Unit 1 was attempting to turn into a parking space and hydroplaned into a cement post in the parking lot.
- 8/19/18 **Backing** | Unit 1 backed out of his parking space at Giant Eagle and struck a parked vehicle (Unit 2) parked directly behind him.
- 8/20/18 **Deer** | Unit 1 was southbound on Sawmill Parkway. In the area of 10560 Sawmill Pkwy, Unit 1 struck a deer that had entered the roadway.
- 8/21/18 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 (unknown) was eastbound on Trail Lake Drive from Sawmill Parkway. Unit 1 left the roadway and struck the mailbox at 8269 Trail Lake Drive.
