
Sex Offense | A victim reported that a sexual assault occurred on Seldom Seen Road. The case is under investigation.





TRAFFIC CRASHES

- 9/5/18 ACDA | Unit 2 was traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy when they started to slow down for an emergency vehicle. Unit 1 was also traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy when they failed to maintain assured clear distance ahead and struck Unit 2 in the rear. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/6/18 **OVI** | Unit 1 was backing out of his parking spot and struck a parked Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/7/18 **Hit-Skip** | Unit 1 improperly backed out of a driveway on Cardinal Hill Lane and as a result struck a tree adjacent to the drive. The driver was identified and cited.

- 9/12/18 Failure to Control | Unit 1 was on Havenrock Lane traveling eastbound. When they turned to go southbound, Unit 1 failed to maintain control of the vehicle and struck a curb and then a tree. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/13/18 **ACDA** | While traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy, Unit 1 rear ended Unit 2. Unit 2 was stationary at the traffic light. Unit 1 was cited.
- 9/17/18 Failure to Yield | *Injury* | Unit 1 was traveling southbound on Moreland Dr. approaching 8771 and Unit 2 was westbound in the parking lot at 8771 Moreland Dr. As Unit 1 turned right into the lot, it struck Unit 2.
- 9/22/18 **OVI** | *Injury* | The driver of Unit 1 was stopped on Grey Oaks at the stop sign with the intersection with Sawmill Road to head west across the intersection. The driver of Unit 1 stated he did not see Unit 2 coming southbound. The driver of Unit 1 entered the intersection and struck Unit 2 causing Unit 2 to leave the right side of the roadway striking several objects. The crash injured the passenger in Unit 2. Unit 1 was cited.
