I. NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES

The minutes from the Nov. 20, 2018 Operations Committee Meeting were approved.

II. FIBER

Assistant Development Director Rocky Kambo reviewed a proposal from Consolidated Electric Cooperative to install fiber from the Municipal Building to the water tower. This would connect to Delaware County's system and provide improved services for emergency services.

**ACTION ITEM: The Committee has requested Rocky to confirm the cost and payment details. Mayor Jon Bennehoof also requested that Rocky prepare a business case for the fiber optic project.**

III. MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENTS REGULATIONS

The City of Powell is considering implementing new license requirements for massage parlors. This is to help prevent businesses from using massage parlors as a facade for prostitution and human trafficking. The City of Westerville recently implemented new license requirements and Powell is reviewing the changes they made.
