Summary of Notable Revenue and Expenditure Items As of April 30, 2019

Revenue

- Municipal Income Tax: We have collected \$1,765,876.57 or 29.01% (through RITA) of our 2019 budget of \$6,086,214.00.
- Municipal Income Tax: Comparing 2019 municipal income tax collection to 2018 (year-to-date period) we are up 8.66%.
- Real Estate Taxes: We collect in two installments (usually March and August). We have collected \$327,906.16 or 51.43% of our \$637,666.20 budget.
- Development Fees: We have collected \$175,096.55 or 28.44% of our 2019 budget of \$622,923.00.
- Local Government Fund: We have collected \$52,739.79 or 30.83% of our 2019 budget of \$171,101.89.
- All Other General Fund Revenues: We have collected \$360,959.80 or 54.65% of our 2019 budget of \$660,514.94.
- Other Fund Revenues:
 - o Parks & Recreation Programs Fund: We have collected \$104,617.20 or 59.79% of our 2019 budget of \$175,000.00 for Recreation; and we collected \$45,475.00 or 34.45% of our 2019 budget of \$132,000.00 for Powell Festival/Special Events plus \$0.00 in sales (budget of \$35,000.00).
 - o Debt Service Funds: We have collected \$697,349.49 or 13.48% of our 2019 budget of \$5,174,863.55.
 - o Downtown TIF: we collected \$201,333.38 or 53.27% of our 2019 budget of \$378,000.00.
 - o Sawmill Corridor TIF: we collected \$189,281.36 or 47.32% of our 2019 budget of \$400,000.00.
 - o Seldom Seen TIF: we collected \$109,706.76 or 52.25% of our 2019 budget of \$210,000.00.

Expenditures

Anticipated percentage range of expenditures is usually 31.0 to 40.0% for April.

- Administration expenditures were \$93,921.94, which is 29.99% of their budget.
- Building expenditures were \$164,689.07, which is 25.92% of their budget.
- Communications expenditures were \$67,405.45, which is 35.88% of their budget.
- Council/Clerk expenditures were \$96,577.45, which is 37.85% of their budget.
- Development expenditures were \$110,556.38, which is 34.66% of their budget.
- Engineering expenditures were \$124,896.75, which is 27.90% of their budget.
- Finance expenditures were \$210,123.60, which is 28.10% of their budget.
- Information Technology expenditures were \$125,625.89, which is 55.79% of their budget.
- Lands & Buildings expenditures were \$54,909.93, which is 21.05% of their budget.
- Other Charges expenditures were \$115,738.93, which is 34.71% of their budget.

- Park Maintenance expenditures were \$151,738.93, which is 34.71% of their budget.
- Police expenditures were \$1,009,328.82, which is 30.62% of their budget.
- Public Service expenditures were \$220,172.73, which is 22.74% of their budget.
- Contingencies as of April, we utilized \$175.00 -----leaving a balance of \$74,825.00.
 \$175.00 for a public record request.
- Other Funds:
 - o Parks & Recreation Program Fund expenditures are \$31,441.13 for recreation, which is 15.92% of their budget. The biggest sessions are the spring and summer. Expenditures are \$6,723.00 for Powell Festival/Special Events, which is 5.38% of their budget.
 - Debt Service Funds expenditures are \$6,068.93, which is 0.12% of their budget of \$5,219,918.78. Expenditures are usually seen in May (for June 1 due date) and November (for December 1 due date).

Other Items of Interest:

▶ The "Development" fees are what we look at to see if approximately 50% of the costs for the Building, Development and Engineering Departments are being covered, by the fees. It is estimated that approximately half of their work is related to city services and those services should be covered by resident taxes.

The City has collected \$175,096.55 in Development-related revenue and the Building, Development and Engineering Department costs are \$400,142.20. As of April, fees collected covered 43.76% of the costs. Below is a chart for the same comparable period:

► The "Programming" revenues are what we look at to see if the Parks Programming is self-sufficient or close to being self-sufficient on direct costs.

The City has collected \$104,617.20 in recreation revenue and the related costs are \$31,441.13. As of April, fees collected covered 300.6% of the costs. Below is a chart for the same comparable period:
