AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2019.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2019 in accordance with the information attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2019 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:
