



# The City of Powell Police Department uses this data to assign officers for selective enforcement efforts.

**Average Speed:** The average speed of all vehicles registered by the StealthStat device.

**85th Percentile:** 85 percent of all vehicles were at this speed or slower.

**Vehicles per Hour:** On busy streets, the device cannot accurately count vehicles in the far lane.

# TRAFFIC CRASHES

DATE	CAUSE	NARRATIVE
7/1/19	Red Light	Unit 1 was traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy. and Unit 2 was turning southbound onto Sawmill Pkwy from Bunker Ln. Unit 1 failed to stop at the traffic control device and struck Unit 2 in the intersection of Bunker Ln and Sawmill Pkwy.
7/2/19	Hit-Skip	While backing from an adjacent parking spot at 8769 Moreland Dr., Unit 1 impacted the rear bumper of Unit 2 with its front passenger bumper. Unit 1 left the scene but was found due to daycare records.
7/2/19	Backing	Unit 2 was parked and unoccupied at 4000 W. Powell Rd when Unit 1 improperly backed into the passenger side of Unit 2.
7/10/19	Mech- anical	Unit 1 was eastbound on Rutherford Rd. Unit 1 suffered a mechanical issue that caused Unit 1 to go off the right side of the roadway with the passenger side of the vehicle, strike two (2) marker signs, before coming to rest completely off the right side of the roadway.
7/18/19	ACDA	Injury   Unit 2 had stopped for slowed traffic, when Unit 1 failed to stop and struck Unit 2 from behind.
7/20/19	Inatten- tion	Injury   Unit 1 was turning into a parking area at 3968 W. Powell Rd., when he struck an individual walking across the parking lot.
7/22/19	Failure to Control	Unit 1 performed a right-hand turn from Trail Lake Dr. onto Sawmill Pkwy traveling southbound. Unit 2 was traveling northbound on Sawmill Pkwy. Unit 1 failed to control and crossed the median causing Unit 2 to strike Unit 1.
